1.5 million lawyers in India

Only 15% of Indian lawyers are women

Only 1.3% judges hail from SC/ST communities

0 Dalit chief justices in24 high courts since 2010

The faultlines in caste, religion and gender have resulted in structural omission and oppression of Dalit and Adivasi communities in the Indian legal landscape, with English-speaking elites dominating the space.

The National Law Scholars Program (NLSP) aims to bridge this gap and achieve educational parity in India.

It creates agents out of India's historically marginalized youth, enabling a more democratic and constitutional India where the masses have the capacity and courage to take charge and be the change in their community.




